Will my name ever be shown?

Your name will only be on the screen when the clickers are paired with the system.

Can we collaborate as a team?

We work to make this as realistic for the National Physical Therapy Exam as possible, and collaborating during the test is not allowed. However, if three of your teammates get the answer right and you do not, your team still receives 75% of the point.

Can/how do we study for this?

The questions are geared for third-year students, so you already know most of this knowledge. However, if you would like to brush up on your studies and even take some online practice questions for the NPTE, then feel free to do so.

Will the audience participate?

We will at times include the audience in discussions. They are a huge source of cheering and support during the event, so bring your classmates, alumni, and professors.

If I get the answer wrong, will I walk away knowing why I got it wrong?

Yes! The whole point of this event is to practice for the NPTE while learning. Each question will have a discussion as to why the correct answer is the correct answer.

Will I know what my individual score is?

When you register, you have the option of requesting your scores. Scores will be emailed the week following the APTA Knowledge Bowl.
